English

Maths



Our topic in Maths this half term is Weight. We will be using key language such as; big/small, heavy/light, and using grams/ kilograms to start to weigh objects We will also be carrying out number work, building confidence in our number recognition, writing and problem solving.

At home you could:

- Listen and join in different counting songs.
- Sort objects in to heavy and light
- Help with some home cooking/ baking, weighing out ingredients using scales
