### Our Topics

During this first half term our topic will be '**Materials and our senses**'. ### English

Our English learning will allow us to explore traditional stories. Our focus stories will include:

- **The Gingerbread Man**
- **Goldilocks and the Three Bears**

### Maths

This half term we will explore matching objects and pictures that are the same and matching numbers to a corresponding group of objects. We will also learn about simple 2D shapes.

Explore different items using your senses - what can you find that is soft, hard, yummy, yucky, noisy, quiet. Can you find things you like to look at or perhaps things you do not like to look at.

Can you find socks that match? What other things can you find that are the same - shoes, gloves etc.

### PE

Deer Class will have PE in the Hall every **Thursday afternoon**. This half term we will be exploring throwing using different sized balls and bean bags.
