Our Topics

During this first half term our topic will be 'Let's Play'. We will be exploring lots of different play ideas, skills and vocabulary that help us during play.

Key Language

Key words that we are focussing on this term are:
want, yes, no, I, me, you, like, Christmas

English

Our English learning will allow us to explore stories about the weather, personal hygiene and Christmas. We will also continue to engage with daily phonics and hand gym activities.

Maths

This half term we will explore groups of objects and linking them to quantities. We will also learn about measurement using height. We will have the opportunity to learn about concept words related to height such as tall and short.

Continued Learning

Explore books linked to the weather, getting dressed and being outside.

Look at photos and pictures of being outside and talk about what clothing is being worn in different weathers. Explore and dress up in sun/bobble hats, sunglasses, scarves, wellies, gloves, rain macs etc.

Explore favourite toys and characters and if they are tall or short when stood next to each other.

PE

Fox class will have PE in the Hall every **Wednesday afternoon**. This half term we will be exploring body co-ordination.
