Topic



Our topic this half term is 'Dinosaurs'. We will be exploring different Dinosaur species and fossils. As well as that we will be looking at the concept of carnivores and herbivores as well as, food chains.

At home you could:

- Have a look at pictures of different dinosaurs.
- Have a tray excavating items- you can hide some objects in flour and then find them.

English



Our topic in English this half term is 'Stories By the Same Author'. The focus texts are all stories written by Kes Gray. During the half term we will be using these books to start to compare characters and settings.

At home you could:

- Start to identify characters from your own books at home.
- Create your own story scenes e.g. beach and farm.
- Blank level questioning when you read stories/ watch videos.

Maths



Our topic in Maths this half term is Position and Direction. We will be using key language relating to position and direction; in, put, behind, in front, turn, left, right, forwards and backwards, aiming to navigate a robot around a map. We will also continue to carrying out number work, building confidence in our number recognition, writing and problem solving.

At home you could:

- Listen and join in different counting songs.
- Take a walk together, using directional language.
- Play hide and seek- hiding items and using positional cues to help find them e.g. look behind the sofa.
