Topic



Our topic this half term is 'Our Community'. Pupils will explore different places in our local community and who can help us. We will identify features of different environments as well as, ways in which we can take care of our local community.

At home you could:

- Explore the outside world, looking and identifying different places near your home e.g. park, road, shop.
- Take pictures of places you like to visit in the community.

English



The focus texts this half term are based upon Topsy and Tim's Adventures. We will be using these books to write parts of our own stories about somewhere we know and like to visit. We will also continue to work on our phonics sounds to help with our reading and spelling.

At home you could:

- Find objects within the home that have initial letter sound e.g. p- pot
- Look at picture of yourselves in places you like and communicate about it.
- Blank level questioning when you read stories/ watch videos.

Maths



Our topic in Maths this half term is Data Collection. We will be using key language relating to Data Collection: more, less, same, with the intent to carry out our own small research studies, collecting data about our school. We will also continue to carrying out number work, building confidence in our number recognition, writing and problem solving.

At home you could:

- Listen and join in different counting songs.
- Create small surveys around the home e.g. how many TV's, tablets, books are in your house. Which has the most?
- Sort objects in to groups e.g. fruit/ veg.
