Maths

This half-term in Maths, we will focus on developing and strengthening our understanding of numbers, including number composition. We will explore how different numbers are made up through a range of practical activities and resources, while also building confidence and fluency in recalling known number facts.

English

This half-term, we will continue to use Colourful Semantics in our writing lessons to further develop our sentence-writing skills. We will use this approach to write different types of sentences about the countries we are learning about in our topic lessons.

We will also continue to engage in our daily reading sessions with a key adult, where we will practise developing our word reading and comprehension skills.

PE

This term, Eagles Class will continue with our weekly swimming sessions every Thursday morning. Please make sure your child brings their swimming kit to school each Thursday.
